




## Copies of Sermons by Petrus Roger (Pope Clement VI) Found in Constance Sermon Collections







- Comments: Schneyer, unaware that this sermon was composed by Petrus Roger, believed that it was addressed to the king of France at the time of the Council of Constance; the rubric in the St. Paul MS notes only that it is a “sermo factus coram rege Francie”. Wood points out that the text in Schneyer’s edition is “a slightly shortened version of the fourteenth-century original.”





- Comments: Hardt incorrectly rendered the thema as “Completi” rather than “Impleti sunt dies purgationis Marie”; Hardt believed it was delivered at Constance, inferring its date as 2 Feb. 1418. Finke followed this in ACC 2:525, but also cited this sermon correctly as “Impleti” in ACC 2:536 from the copy in the Zeitz (Stettin) MS. The Pommersfelden catalogue cites the preacher as Leonardus Statius (Dati) and dates it to 1 January 1417, though the manuscript provides neither the date nor the preacher’s name, and cites Finke ACC 2:480; thus obviously confusing this sermon with Dati’s “Compertum habes...”. Kaepelli (3:75, #2841) perpetuated and this mistake by creating an entry for this sermon (#2841) under Dati’s name and compounded the problem by citing its year as 1414, rather than 1417. Note that the incipit (from the Krakow MS) does not match the incipit in Schneyer.



- Comments: Hardt and Walch both believed it was preached at Constance on 1 Jan. 1417, though their source MS does not provide a rubric or colophon; Finke (ACC 2:482) perpetuated this claim. Schneyer, unaware that it is a sermon by Petrus Roger, states (Erganzung 374) that it was delivered by Dietrich von Münster; the copy in the St. Paul MS does not name the preacher, but the register at the beginning of the codex notes that the following sermon is by that preacher; this is probably the source of Schneyer's error.





The rubric in the Erlangen MS claims that it was delivered at Constance. The rubric in the Trier MS notes that it is on St. Nicholas the bishop, whose feastday is 6 Dec.




